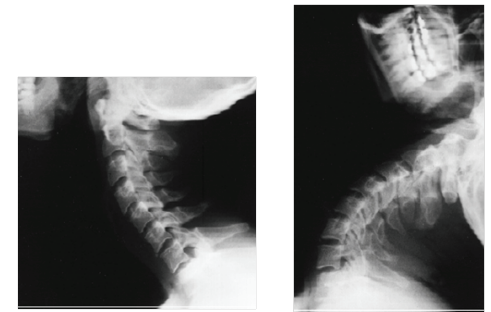

About the Course

DRS starts with a structured assessment system designed to isolate the source(s) of the patient's symptoms, signs and interference with their normal activities. This leads to one of six treatment strategies to gain control over these clinical findings, guide the patient's return to normal activities and develop tools and a plan to prevent recurrence. A 5-step process to identify cautions and contraindications to physical therapy is presented.

The tools include biomechanical/ergonomic procedures, joint and soft-tissue mobilization techniques, therapeutic exercises and a structured program for the patient with non-mechanical symptoms; these are the 'Tools to Fight Back®'.

The workshop includes practice applying the assessment and treatment procedures within the context of a range of potential findings and responses to biomechanical and functional procedures. The participant leaves the workshop with new tools that can be applied to patient treatment the next day, as well as refinement of old tools that render them more clinically effective. As always with DRS courses, the treatment of 'real' patients enhances the educational experience of the workshop and helps the participant to develop more effective strategies for clinical application. Both external and internal evidence will be provided to support use of the various treatment strategies to be practiced.
